

WEBINAR: LEAD TESTING IN SCHOOL DRINKING WATER

The New York State Education Department and the New York State Department of Health are hosting an informational webinar on the recently enacted legislation, which requires all school districts and boards of cooperative educational services (BOCES) to test all potable water outlets for lead contamination, and to take responsive actions.

Generally the webinar will include information on the Lead Testing in Drinking Water regulations, and developments so far with respect to the Building Aid, associated with the testing and remediation required by the law.

A ninety (90) minute webinar will be held on Friday September 16, 2016, starting at 9:30 am.
